## Product Overview

Convenient, economical, fast-acting control of resistant kochia and many other important broadleaf weeds in small grains, fallow, on-farm non-crop, and CRP acres.

## Advantages of Colt + Sword

**MORE** dead weeds. Controls or suppresses 89 weed species.

**MORE** modes of activity for resistance management. The systemic activity of **COLT + SWORD** shuts down weeds within hours.

Wide use window (3-leaf crop growth stage up to and flag leaf emergence) with outstanding crop safety.

## Directions for Use

Apply as a broadcast treatment when wheat, barley or oats are between the 3-leaf crop stage up to and including flag leaf emergence.

Apply to actively growing weeds prior to 8-inch height or vining.

Rate: 1 pint/acre for weeds less than 4 inches tall, 1½ - 2 ¾ pint/acre for taller or vining weeds. 1½ - 2 ¾ pint/acre for volunteer potatoes.

In areas with dicamba-tolerant kochia and for long-term resistance management, use 1½ pint/acre.

An adjuvant such as **Liberate**<sup>®</sup> may optimize herbicidal activity of applications made at lower use rates or lower carrier volumes, in cool temperatures, low relative humidity or drought, or to small, heavily pubescent kochia. **Activator 90** should be used when **COLT + SWORD** is tank mixed with certain products such as sulfonylurea herbicides.

Use at least 8 gallons of water/acre by ground or 3 gallons/acre by air.

Only weeds emerged at application will be controlled.
